We'd love you to send in stories under 1,000 words responding to the title – the fantastic, the realistic, wherever you would like to take it – and the best ten will be included in the book. Yes, you will be paid: \$150 for a *published* story. Not only that, your scribbings will be given to local crafters, whose artistic responses will also be published in the book, and included in a local exhibition.

The guidelines:

- You must be under 30 and live in Tasmania to enter
- Your piece of fiction must be no longer than 1,000 words
- It must respond to the theme 'I Sleep In Haysheds and Corners'
- It must be previously unpublished
- Please complete the entry form below and submit it with your piece

- The entry itself should be anonymous – we have your details below, simply include the title of the piece and a page number on every page
- Use 12 point font and 1.5 spacing
- Print on one side of the page only
- Print two copies of your entry please!
